### Studies and Work experiences:

- March 05- A participant in the European Trade Management program (ETM) with the **Swedish Trade Council**. This is an international vocational training program. ETM Export Trainee offers university graduates a comprehensive career program in small and medium-sized enterprises and the prospect of becoming an International Trade Specialist. ETM is part of an EU project aimed at creating European-certified education in Trade Management, making Trade Management an internationally recognised profession and enhancing the export expertise of companies growing internationally.
- Aug 00-04 **Bachelor in Economics at the University of Kalmar, Sweden**. The program is called the Baltic Business Program, which is an economy program with focus on East European countries, and the Baltic Sea States in particular. My focus has been towards marketing, but I also have fundamental knowledge in accounting and book keeping. I have occasionally been helping my father at his company and therefore I have gained a lot of practical knowledge and experience. My Bachelor were completed during 2004 in the US.
- April 03- When needed I am working at **Securitas** as a security guard. My main duties are to supervise and keep an eye on the production premises at a large company in the export industry, mostly at night to prevent trespassing and to keep unauthorized people away. Other duties are to answer the phone and to be available in the reception/entrance to help customers. I am the company's face outward and therefore it's of importance to be socially outgoing, able to take action and delegate responsibility.
- April 98- I started working for **Kährs Group in Nybro** in spring 1998. The company is a major manufacturer within the board floor industry. I worked out in the production line making the board floors. We worked together closely in different teams where each team was responsible for quality and that we maintained the pace of the production. I learned a great deal about working close with others, how to build a good team and how to make it more efficient. I also learned how to cope with stress; it was often a high pace in the production.
- June 95- After Upper Secondary School I have often helped my father in his **small firm in the forest industry**. My duties have been very varying, I have been driving different machines such as forwarders and harvesters, but mostly been in the office taking care of the bookkeeping and common office work. I know the importance of being careful and to keep things in order and not to rush through anything.
- Aug 94- During my final year in Upper Secondary School I worked as a **trainee at a local Bank**. I experienced different divisions of the bank such as being in customer service and answering the phone, or maybe assisting the teller with common tasks. I also participated in the fund managers daily work buying and selling bonds and stocks. The job is very exciting, you have to be extremely social and outgoing as a person and you must also be able to socialize with different kinds of people.

Apart from speaking Swedish and English I also speak German and a little bit Russian and French.
